

DRESS POLICY



It is important to maintain the gracious atmosphere of the Sunset Club. Judgment in attire should be guided by decorum and mutual respect.

BUSINESS CASUAL ATTIRE

For ladies and gentlemen over the age of 18, suitable attire is business casual, except in circumstances listed below. Business casual may include dressy denim. Coats should be hung in the appropriate closets.

EVENING OR DRESSY ATTIRE

Certain special events require dressy attire. Those will be announced in the Bulletin or through email.

Dressy attire is a coat and tie for gentlemen.

FUNCTIONS OUTSIDE REGULAR HOURS

Events held outside the regular operating hours may select their attire.

CHILDREN'S ATTIRE

Children should be dressed in appropriate attire for their age and the occasion.

OVERNIGHT GUESTS

Guests are asked to follow the dress code policy when eating in the Dining Room, attending an event in the Ballroom, or sitting in the Drawing Room. Clothing such as t-shirts, jeans, active sports clothing, beachwear, athletic shoes or flip flops is not acceptable attire at the Sunset Club, however casual clothing is acceptable for overnight guests.

Private banquet functions outside the regular operating hours will determine the dress code for their events.
